Day 1: FLY TO NORWAY

Depart the United States for an overnight flight to Europe and the charm of Norway & Iceland.

Included Meals: Light Dinner & Breakfast on Plane

Day 2: ARRIVE OSLO, NORWAY

Upon arrival in Oslo, we'll visit the Holmenkollen Ski Jump Museum, the oldest of its kind in the world, presenting over 4,000 years of skiing history and Norwegian polar exploration. The new modern Ski Jump is an Oslo landmark and the observation deck offers panoramic views of Oslo. Later we see the new Oslo Opera House, built to resemble a glacier. Its sloping carrara marble roof is a public pedestrian plaza, revealing different angles of the inner city and the picturesque Akerbrygge harbor. The rest of the afternoon is at leisure before a Welcome Dinner at the hotel this evening. Overnight in Oslo.

Day 3: OSLO CITY TOUR

A Norwegian guide will escort us on a city tour of Oslo: At the Viking Ship Museum, an impressive collection of 1000-year-old ships and ornate sledges and carriages makes history come alive. In the near-by open-air Norsk Folkemuseum, 160 buildings from different regions in Norway provide a taste of the Norwegian way of life, past and present. The Gol Stave Church dating from 1200 is one of five medieval buildings at the museum. This afternoon we will see Munch's "Scream" and Norwegian landscape paintings at the Norwegian National Gallery. Stop in the impressive City Hall to view the murals in its grand Blue Hall, where the Nobel Peace Prizes are presented, then wander through Frogner Park to view Vigeland's huge col-

lection of sculptures portraying the human condition, inspired by Rodin and completed in 1949. Overnight in Oslo. Included Meals: Breakfast

Day 4: NORWAY BY TRAIN

Starting from Oslo, you first set out on a westbound train journey through scenic mountain terrain on the Bergen Railway. Upon arrival in Myrdal, you disembark and change trains to the legendary Flåm Railway. The Flåm Railway offers spectacular panoramic views to some of the wildest and most magnificent nature in the Norwegian fjord landscape. Your journey continues from Flåm with a fjord cruise on the magnificent Aurlandsfjord and on the and dramatic and narrow Nærøyfjord. The Aurlandsfjord is a picturesque fjord that offers stunning views, while the Nærøyfjord is a dramatic fjord surrounded by high mountains. Nærøyfjorden is one of the narrowest fjords in Europe and included on UNESCO's World Heritage List. After your fjord cruise you arrive in the small village of Gudvangen, nestled in the innermost part of Nærøyfjorden. Overnight in Stalhaim.

Day 5: NORWAY FJORDS

Spend a full day free to enjoy the relaxing nature. There are plenty of activities to include such as kayaking, fjord safari's hiking etc. Overnight in Stalhaim.

Day 6: BERGEN & SCENIC TRAINS

From here the journey continues with a coach trip through Nærøydalen, with its charming villages and scenic nature land-scape. From May-September the bus travels down the steep hairpin bends of Stalheimskleiva. The coach will arrive in Voss, where you continue the tour by train on the Bergen Railway to Bergen. Perhaps cap the day by riding up the funicular to the top of 2,000-foot-tall "Mount" Fløyen for city and fjord views. Overnight in Bergen.

Day 7: BERGEN

A UNESCO World Heritage city, ancient Bergen looms large in Viking sagas. Until the 14th century, it was the seat of the medieval kingdom of Norway. This history comes alive as we join our guide for a walk along the historic Bryggen wharf and visit the Hanseatic Museum, in an old merchant house. Seafaring Bergen has given the world two cultural icons -- playwright Henrik Ibsen and composer Edvard Grieg. Late morning, drive to Troldhaugen, the home of Edvard Grieg and his wife. This typical 19th century residence with a panoramic tower and large veranda overlooks Nordas Lake. Visit the house where Greig spent his last 22 years, the museum, the graveyard, and the hut where he composed music. After time for a light lunch (on own) at the Troldhaugen Café, enjoy a concert of Grieg's music in a special concert hall. Tour ends at the hotel and the remaining of the day is at leisure to explore the old city. Stroll through the narrow alleyways and overhanging galleries of a bygone era, from the lively Fish Market to the Bergenhus Fortress, with cafés and boutiques selling traditional and unique

Day 8: ICELAND & BLUE LAGOON

Bergen's seaport. Overnight in Bergen.

Today it is time to say farewell to Norway and catch a flight to Reykjavik, Iceland. Upon arrival we will visit the famous Blue Lagoon. The Blue Lagoon is one of Iceland's most popular attractions, a natural geothermal pool in the middle of a large and dramatic lava field and an oasis that owes its existence to a nearby geothermal power plant, looming large over the aqua tinted waters. We stop for 1 ½ hour for a refreshing bathe or a swim in the inviting, rejuvenating and pleasantly warm mineral-rich water (100-110°F), reputed for its healing properties. Continue to your hotel in Reykjavik for check-in. Overnight Reykjavik.

Day 9: REYKJAVIK & GOLDEN CIRCLE

Today you will have a highlight of Icelandic nature experiencing the "Golden Circle." This route takes in three of the most



visited attractions in Iceland: Thingvellir National Park, Gullfoss (Golden Waterfall) and the world-famous Geysir. We'll drive towards Haukadalur, a geothermally active valley where the hot spring Geysir is located - watch it burst up in the air every 5-10 minutes. We also visit one of Iceland's most renowned waterfalls, Gullfoss, created where the Hvita river plunges into 105 feet deep crevice. On our way to Thingvellir National Park, we'll make a short stop by Laugarvatn Geothermal Bakery. Guests can experience the geothermal bakery first hand and have a demonstration of how rye bread can be baked in the boiling grounds at Laugarvatn. Over a scenic route we reach Thingvellir National Park and UNESCO World Heritage Site. We stroll around the country's most sacred site, home of the oldest existing parliament in the world, the Althingi, and major events in our history. Thingvellir is a place of fascinating natural beauty, one of the most geologically spectacular, set on a vast plain flanked by large fissures, right on Iceland's largest lake, Thingvallavatn. The Great Atlantic rift is clearly visible; a rift that is slowly pulling Iceland apart along tectonic plates and you can literally walk between the American and Eurasian continental plates. Overnight Reykjavik.

Day 10: SNAEFELLSNES

The Snæfellsnes peninsula northwest of Reykjavik is like a miniature of the whole country of Iceland. There are white and black beaches, bird cliffs, spectacular mountains and volcanic craters, incredibly rich trout lakes and salmon rivers lush valleys, unique harbours in charming fishing villages and a world renowned glacier. You'll look at stunning rock formations and teeming bird life at the lovely communities of Arnarstapi and Hellnar, and stop at the gorgeous beach Djúpalónssandur, with its otherworldly views and rich history. The serene and majestic Snæfellsjökull glacier, considered one of the seven great energy centers of the earth, stands 1,446 m high and provided the setting for Jules Vernes' famous Journey to the Center of the Earth. Return to Reykjavik.

Day 11: REYKJAVIK LEISURE TIME & FLIGHT HOME Enjoy a leisure morning in Reykjavik before leaving in early afternoon for the airport and your flight home.
